2025 Fall Leaf Collection

The City of Gloversville will begin collecting bagged leaves on Monday, October 27, 2025, and will continue through Friday, November 14, 2025. Loose leaves will not be collected.

BAGGED LEAF PICK-UP SCHEDULE

From October 27 - November 14, bagged leaves will be collected. To ensure collection, please have your bagged leaves on the terrace or just before the edge of the curb by 7am on the scheduled collection week for your ward.

WARDS 2 & 4 10/27/25 – 10/31/25

WARDS 3 & 5 11/3/25 – 11/7/25

WARDS 1 & 6 11/10/25 -11/14/25

DO place leaves out as soon as possible to ensure collection. To maximize efficiencies and enhance collection efforts, we ask that residents not park cars on the street during your collection week or move cars off the street while crews are present collecting leaves from 7 am to 3 pm as parked cars hamper leaf collection efficiency

DO NOT contaminate the leaves with trash or other yard waste such as branches, sticks or plastic bags. Loose leaves, tree limbs and sticks will not be collected. Those items can be taken to the Beaver Street brush drop-off located at the dead end of Beaver Street, which is available to Gloversville residents for organic waste only. No trash or construction debris may be dumped at that location and the site is under 24-hour police camera surveillance.

DO NOT rake, blow, or dump leaves onto any roadway or any city owned property including parks and the center islands located on East Boulevard, Oakland Avenue and Judson Parkway.
