Monday – Friday: 7:15 AM - 3:00 PM

Saturday: 7:15 AM - 11:30 AM

Mud Road Transfer Station Permits are available, for Gloversville City residents only, through the City Clerk's Office located at 3 Frontage Rd.

Landfill permits are **valid** from **January 1st through December 31st**.

Cost

\$40.00 - if purchased between January 1st through August 31st.

\$25.00 - if purchased on or after September 1st through December 31st.

Application for Permit

While City Hall is back open to the public, feel free to also take advantage of the alternate ways to obtain your landfill permit.

In person: You will need your license and registration of the vehicle that will be used for the permit, along with your payment.

By phone: You can pay with credit card over the phone by calling the City Clerk's office. There is a \$1.75 fee added for this service. Email a picture of the registration of the vehicle that will be used, and a picture of your license to depclerk@cityofgloversville.com.

Drop box: You will need a copy of your license and registration of the vehicle that will be used for the permit, along with your payment included in a sealed envelope to the City Clerk. The drop box is located outside of City hall, from our public parking lot.

Please make sure to use the drop box marked for the **City Clerk's office**.

By mail: You can mail in your payment and copy of your license and registration of the vehicle that will be used for the permit to City Clerk's office; 3 Frontage Road; Gloversville, NY 12078.

Check or money order can be made out to 'Gloversville City Clerk'.

Important Landfill Information

- Gloversville City residents **must** have proof of residency by having your **Driver's License and Vehicle Registration**.
- Many of the items that are not acceptable for curbside pick-up are acceptable to be dropped off at the landfill. This includes appliances (stoves, washers, dryers etc.), furniture, vehicle batteries, propane tanks, fluorescent bulbs and used motor oil.
- Freon containing appliances (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers) are accepted at the landfill *only* (no transfer stations). There is no charge to dispose of Freon-containing units to Fulton County residents (businesses pay \$5 each). Fridge and freezer doors should be removed.
- Tires (off the rim) may be brought to the landfill (no transfer stations). There is a nominal disposal fee. Open to all county residents.

Transfer Station Rules

- Permit stickers **MUST** be adhered to the vehicle listed with your permit application.
- Equivalent of five pick up truck loads worth for any single project. Do **NOT** bring 5 loads in one day! Please space them out.
- Attendants are not expected to help with disposal - If you got an item into your vehicle, you should arrange your own assistance to deposit it at the station.
- Trailer size - No larger than 5' x 8'.
- No dump trucks or dump trailers allowed.
- NO U-hauls allowed.
- NO black bags allowed.
- Loose loads must be covered to prevent litter.
- Please clean up after yourself.
- Transfer stations are for residential use only - no businesses allowed! Landlords are considered to be in business.
- Freon containing units and tires are **ONLY ACCEPTED** at the Department of Solid Waste, 847 Mud Road, Johnstown. Fees apply. Tires must be off the rim.
- Do **NOT** dispose of hot ashes in the containers - this creates a fire hazard.
- No Smoking!
- Stations with hoppers - Keep back 5 feet from hoppers as a safety precaution.
- Electronics and vehicle batteries must be recycled - they are **NOT** allowed in the garbage.
- Liquid waste is prohibited.
- Cement blocks - DSW recommends finding a clean fill location.
- Closing time - Residents must be unloaded and out of the station by closing time. Attendants have the right to refuse to allow a resident to unload if it will prevent the station from closing at the assigned time.
- Dead animals/carcasses are not allowed at the station - Call the DSW for disposal arrangements - Fee applies.
- Recycling containers are available at all stations - recycling is the law in Fulton County and NYS - Do not throw recyclables in with garbage.
- No out of county waste is accepted at any transfer station - you must be a resident of the municipality in order to use the station serving that municipality.
- Scavanging is prohibited - all materials deposited at the station are the property of Fulton County.
- Stumps are not allowed at transfer stations.
- Boards should be no longer than three feet long and six inches in diameter.
- Tree Limbs - DSW recommends finding a clean fill location.
