The Gloversville Recreation Commission is now accepting vendors for their 2025 events!

Vendor Savings Opportunity – Save money by booking multiple events! The Gloversville Recreation Commission has four opportunities for vendors in 2025 and the more you book, the more you save. The total fee due must be paid in advance of the first event to receive the discount.

Southern Adirondack Wine and Food Festival – June 7, 2025; 3pm-8pm

Held annually on the first Saturday in June, the Wine and Food Festival is a great kickoff to the summer. This event takes place on our historic Main Street with wine, beer and cider tastings, along with many food and good vendors. The sound of music fills the streets with live performances in two separate locations throughout the event. This is a very popular event in the city and attracts roughly 3,000 attendees. Admission is free for non-tasters, those interested in sampling receive a free gift with their \$15 admission fee.

Railfest - August 9, 2025; 10am-8pm

Railfest is a long-standing event in the City of Gloversville and takes place in Trail Station Park on the second Saturday of August. This is the city's only daylong event, running from 10am until 8pm and has many attractions like bounce houses, petting zoo, dunk tank, bicycle auction, a large vendor fair and more. The main stage sees many different performers and bands throughout the day. This event sees upwards of 5,000 attendees throughout the day and is our biggest fundraising event.

Bacon & Brew Fest – September 20, 2025; 4pm-9pm

Held annually on the fourth Saturday of September at the Farmer's Market Pavilion, Bacon and Brew Fest is a fun evening out in the city. A beer garden hosts four different local vendors selling beer, wine and cider by the glass. The main stage is set up with live bands providing entertainment for the entire event. Many food vendors provide bacon themed menus with crafts and good vendors selling their items throughout the event. This is a laid-back evening, enjoying live music and alcoholic beverages under the stars.

Fall Fest – October 11, 2025; 11am-4pm

Held annually on the first Saturday of October in Trail Station Park, Fall Fest provides many free children's activities for our community. Children can enjoy bounce houses, pumpkin paintings, and jumbo yard games at no cost. Many free contests are held, including potato sack races, three-legged race, and hula hoop contests, with prizes awarded. At the end of the event, children change into their Halloween costumes and parade through the many vendors trick or treating. Special judges award ribbons to the costume contest winners.

Rain dates:

All events listed above have a rain date of Sunday, the day immediately following the event.

Booth Fees:

\$35 per 10' x 10' space \$40 per 10' x 15' space \$55 per 10' x 20' space \$60 per 10' x 25' space \$65 per 10' x 30' space \$70 per 10' x 40' space \$75 for food vendors

Electricity (spaces are limited and granted on a first come, first served basis):

\$15 additional charge\$75 additional charge for food vendors

Payment: Booth payments must be made ten business days before the date of the event. Any payments made on the day of the event will incur a \$10 surcharge fee. Direct sales will be approved on a first-come, first-served basis on payment being received.

Non-Profit Organizations: there will be no charge for vendor fees with a valid certificate unless collecting money which includes the sale of products for fundraising. Monetary donations are appreciated to help support the Recreation Commission.
