



Garbage Collection Guidelines:

- All carts must be out by 5:30AM the day of collection.
- Carts must be placed within 6-feet of the curb or edge of roadway for the automated mechanical arm to reach. Carts placed elsewhere or on top of snowbanks will not be collected.
- Only household trash items are permitted which are required to be placed in white or clear trash bags only, then deposited into your cart. No recycling is allowed in the container. Please see list below of unacceptable items.
- All garbage set out curbside must be contained within your roll cart. Additional bags, extra containers, loose garbage, or bulk items set outside the cart will not be collected.
