
Job Description

LIGHT EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work involves responsibility for the safe and efficient operation of various types of light motor equipment including small tractors and dump trucks used in construction and repair of roads and related public works activities. The work is performed under general supervision in accordance with established policies and procedures. General instructions are received regarding routine work assignments and detailed or specific instructions are received regarding new or unusual assignments. Supervision may be exercised over the work of subordinate employees as assigned. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Operates a truck in connection with the hauling of material for road construction and repair, removal of snow and ice, refuse and garbage;

Operates a truck to transport other workers, tools and other equipment;

Operates a snow plow, salt truck, snow blowers, skid steer loader or other related snow removal equipment;

Operates a sewer jet truck and vac truck;

Operates hand mowers, tractor mowers, weed trimmers, chain saws and brush chippers;

Services assigned vehicle and maintains it in clean condition;

Loads and unloads trucks;

Performs a variety of simple manual tasks, such as cleaning culverts and storm drains, flushing sewers, shoveling snow, painting, general building repairs and road maintenance work;

The above examples of duties are intended only as an illustration of the various types of work to be performed. The omission of specific statements or duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related or a logical assignment to the position.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Good knowledge of the operation of dump trucks, small tractors and other types of light motor equipment;

Able to service and make simple repairs to light equipment;

Ability to understand and carry out simple oral or written work instructions;

Willingness to respond to emergencies and occasionally work under adverse weather conditions;

Mechanical aptitude;

Dependability.

Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: One year of experience in the operation of light motor equipment.

SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL - Class B)
