2024 Yard Waste & Brush Collection

BAGGED YARD WASTE AND BRUSH WILL BE COLLECTED ON THE FOLLOWING DATES ACCORDING TO YOUR GARBAGE COLLECTION DAY:

YARD WASTE & BRUSH COLLECTION SCHEDULE	
Garbage Day	COLLECTION DATES
Monday	4/29, 6/3, 7/8, 8/12, 9/16, 10/21
Tuesday	4/30, 6/4, 7/9, 8/13, 9/17, 10/22
Wednesday & Thursday	5/2, 6/6, 7/11, 8/15, 9/19, 10/24
Friday	5/3, 6/7, 7/12, 8/16, 9/20, 10/25

Any yard waste or brush set out after your garbage day during these dates will not be collected.

Yard waste and brush collection will be limited to the following:

- Unlimited number of paper yard waste bags can be set out. 50-pound weight limit for each yard waste bag.
- Any loose brush set out will need to be tied or bundled together for collection. Limbs are limited in size to 4” in diameter and no longer than 6-feet in length.
- The volume of any brush material cut up to be collected must be limited to 10-feet in length, 5-feet in width and no taller than 5-feet high.
- Limbs larger than 4” in diameter and/or longer than 6 feet in length will not be collected. Larger limbs can be taken to the brush drop-off site located near the dead-end of Beaver Street.

*** The city will not collect any loose leaves at all. Any loose leaves must be contained within paper yard bags.**

*** The city will not collect any leaves or yard waste set out in plastic bags.**

* After October 25th, there will be no brush or bundled small limbs collected of any kind – only leaves and other organic material that can fit inside paper yard waste bags will be collected beginning in late-October through mid-November to coincide with the fall loose leaf collection program.
